The Board approved the last of the proposals from Superior Landscape for replacing the last few sections of our irrigation system. This work will be ongoing for the next couple months with the goal of completing before the fall overseeding. The irrigation system installed in 1980-81 was beyond its useful life and had been planned for replacement and budgeted for approximately three years ago. The cost of the irrigation work to date is less than the original budget amount and the HOA should begin to see some savings in water cost as well as improved health of our landscape.
