TENNIS COURT UPDATE

We have resealed the tennis court with new striping, new net and new lights above.

The blue lines are for two pickleball courts. People asked why they are laid out this direction, but if you were there when the photos were taken you would see it is to avoid anyone looking into the sun.





The pickleball nets are portable with some assembly required.

CONDITIONS OF WINNING

- 1. Pickleballs and tennis balls make noise. Please comply with the Rules: court hours are from 6:30 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. Don't have the lights on after 11:00.
- 2. Please limit your court time to one hour, especially if anyone is waiting.
- 3. Keep voices appropriate the neighbors are close.
- 4. Proper etiquette should be followed at all times: i.e. DO NOT:
 - (a) use profanity,
 - (b) interfere with the court when a ball is in play
 - (c) use tennis court as a short cut
 - (d) hit tennis court net in anger
 - (e) lean on net
 - (f) smoke in court
 - (g) allow pets of any kind in court.
- 5. No one may disturb those playing tennis or pickle ball while a game is in progress.
- 6. Disassemble the pickleball nets and store them after use.
- 7. Clean up before you leave.
