# PRESIDENT'S REPORT OF HOA ADVANCES 2021-2023

- Convinced the City to take possession of water drainage area outside our walls
- Convinced City of Phoenix to designate Cool Corridor
  - Replaced landscaping company
  - Major replacement of landscaping water system
  - Water---Specialist and the community starting to be more aware of how to conserve water (many residents removing grass from their backyards and adding recycling pumps hot water tanks)
  - Water meter not in use removed from our bill
  - Filling out the required form to water company to get a rebate for some of our sewer bills (they estimate water that is used for the grass)
  - We also have a specialist which we can hire this coming year to tweak our sprinkling heads to save water and not water the sidewalks as much as possible
  - Replace trees and shrubs
  - Dedicated South Pool area as Lori Porter Recreation area
  - New bench—Nathan's Garden, South Pool
  - Reseal streets-Charles
  - Reseal tennis court with new net, new striping and new LED Lites
  - Completed new Five-Year Plan
  - Website now has our monthly meeting link attached and it is the same month to month
  - We have our monthly newsletters running (last two years)
  - Welcome letter created (two years ago)
  - Social events up and running again-two to three times a year
  - We also started putting back into CD's which is generating income for the community
  - Our budget is back under control and we are now on a new track to saving for larger long-term Expenditures vs using all our reserve account in the current fiscal year
  - Put up a very needed stop sign at the corner of 40<sup>th</sup> and Larkspur
  - Architectural guidelines updated Color of doors added
  - Speed bump repositioned on Larkspur
  - Two years ago, locks changed on pool bathroom doors to combination locks (keeping non-residents from sleeping in our bathrooms).
