Gates at the pool and tennis courts are being propped open and left open. The first problem is that these amenities are for you, our residents, and your guests, paid for through a portion of your HOA fees. They are not for people not associated with Las Haciendas. The second problem is liability: an open gate lets anyone into the pool or tennis courts. If there is an accident or, forbiddingly, a drowning, Las Haciendas will be financially and morally responsible. Thirdly, we are experiencing unusual wear on pool chairs (needing replacement) and trash (not in the trash cans). Your HOA Board pleads with you to, please, not prop open or leave gates open at either of the pools or tennis courts. Thank you for your support and cooperation.
